



"LSWCC 50th Anniversary celebrated with Premier League title win.

The 2013/2014 season marked the LSWCC's 50th anniversary and what better way to celebrate it than to win the Premier League title.

LSWCC since its inception has proved to be the most successfully independent club in the history of the Hong Kong Cricket Association. Despite limited funds and facilities the Club has continued to defy the odds. A committed management, strong junior player development programme, team spirit and a desire to achieve are the keys to this success.

The winning of the Premier League by our Prism team was matched by high quality performances by our teams in all HKCA's league competitions.

Our under 11's and under 13's won their respective titles while the under 16's and under 19's were runners up in their league competitions.

In the other Sunday League competitions our teams, LSW JKN and LSW Knights came 3rd and 4th respectively

In the Saturday league our teams, LSW Sarjan and LSW Warriors came 3rd and 4th respectively.

Our women's team is also beginning to make its presence felt and have recorded few wins. This success is resulting in more and more women joining LSWCC and the team will undoubtedly see further success in seasons to come. The team's season was crowned with two members being chosen to represent Hong Kong. They were Shanzeen Shahzad and Sidra Hussain.

LSWCC men also played important roles for the Hong Kong National team during the season, with Nizakat Khan, Moner Dar and Baber Hayat shining at ICC international events played in Abu Dhabi and Malaysia.

The success of Club teams was in part due to the commitment and drive of the Clubs coaching staff who continue to find and develop and mould new talent. Without the drive and skill of these coaches LSWCC would not be in the position it is today. The festivities included a dinner at the KCC, an afternoon BBQ, culminating in a match and dinner at the HKCC.

The match, at the HKCC against a HKCC Taverners team, resulted in a LSWCC team, made up of past players, along with a few present members achieving a memorable six wicket victory.

Several past players at the end of these festivities agreed to become Life Members. They are; Tony Turner, Gordon Bacon, Richard Flood, Neil Brodie, Neil Maloney, Rizwan Farouq, Mark Roberts and Roger Vergellius. Their generous contributions will be used to develop the Clubs youth programme and a ground which is currently being sought in Shekipmei.

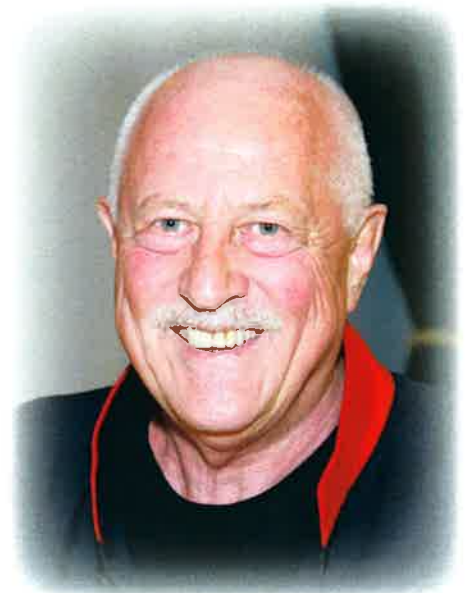
